TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

IN CONSIDERATION OF THE UNDERSIGNED PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN (THE "UNDERSIGNED") AND/OR THE MINOR PARTICIPANT NAMED BELOW BEING PERMITTED TO ENTER THE BOYS & GIRLS CLUB OF PASADENA (THE "CLUB") FOR ANY PURPOSE INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO OBSERVATION, USE OF FACILITIES OR EQUIPMENT, COMMUNITY SERVICE WORK, VOLUNTEER WORK OR PARTICIPATION IN ANY WAY, THE UNDERSIGNED, ON BEHALF OF HIMSELF/HERSELF AND THE MINOR PARTICIPANT, HEREBY AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTUAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. INSPECTION.** The undersigned, for himself/herself and on behalf of the minor participant acknowledges, agrees and represents that he or she has, or immediately upon entering will, inspect the Club's premises and facilities. The undersigned further warrants that by entering into the Club for any purpose whatsoever (other than for the initial safety inspection) he/she is acknowledging that he/she has inspected the Club's premises, facilities and equipment and that he/she finds and accepts them as being safe and reasonably suited for the purposes of his/her and/or the minor participant's use.
- 2. PHYSICAL CONDITION.** The undersigned warrants that the minor participant has no physical or medical condition which would endanger him/her or others when engaging in the Club's program/activities/events, or that would interfere with the participant's ability to participate in the Club's program/activities/events.
- 3. WAIVER.** The undersigned for himself/herself and on behalf of the minor participant waives and releases the Club, its employees, directors, officers and agents from any liability for any damages or injuries suffered by the undersigned and/or the minor participant resulting from the negligent or intentional act or omission of another participant or other third party.
- 4. INDEMNITY (Undersigned's acts).** The undersigned on behalf of himself/herself and the minor participant hereby agrees to indemnify and hold the Club harmless from any loss, liability, damage, or cost (including attorneys' fees) the Club may incur as a result of any negligent or intentional act or omission of the undersigned or the minor participant while on the Club's premises or engaging in any of the Club's program/activities/events. In the event any suit on any claim is brought against the Club as a result of the negligent or intentional act or omission of the undersigned or the minor participant, the undersigned shall defend said suit at the undersigned's own cost and expense, and shall pay and satisfy any lien or judgment asserted or entered against the Club.
- 5. INDEMNITY (Club's acts).** The undersigned on behalf of himself/herself and the minor participant hereby agrees to indemnify and hold the Club harmless from any loss, liability, damage, or cost (including attorneys' fees) the Club may incur as a result of the active negligence of the Club as it relates to the undersigned and/or the minor participant. In the event any suit on any claim is brought against the Club as a result of the Club's active negligence as it relates to the undersigned and/or the minor participant, the undersigned shall defend said suit at the undersigned's own cost and expense, and shall pay and satisfy any lien or judgment asserted or entered against the Club.
- 6. ASSUMPTION OF RISK.** The undersigned on behalf of himself/herself and the minor participant hereby assumes full responsibility for and risk of bodily injury, death or property damage as a result of his/her or the participant's acts or omissions while on the Club's premises and/or as a result of the undersigned and/or the participant's participation in any of the Club's program/activities/events.
- 7. MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION.** In the event of an emergency, as determined by the Club in its discretion, or where the Club is unable to contact the undersigned or to secure his/her consent in case of a medical emergency involving the minor participant, the undersigned hereby gives the Club and it's representatives permission to secure proper medical care and assistance for the minor participant, including, but not limited to, hospitalization, treatment, medication or x-rays. The undersigned further authorizes any treating physician to use his or her discretion in providing emergency treatment to the minor participant. The undersigned agrees to be responsible for and pay any and all costs relating to the participant's medical care, including the use of paramedics.
- 8. PHOTOGRAPHS.** The undersigned hereby consents to the public and/or promotional use of any photograph, video or related media coverage taken of him/her and/or the minor participant while on the Club's premises or while participating in any Club sponsored activity. The undersigned waives any compensation arising or related to the use of the photograph, video or related media or any right to inspect or approve of said photograph, video or related media prior to publication or release.
- 9. VALIDITY.** The undersigned expressly agrees that the foregoing contractual provisions are intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of California and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, the balance shall continue in full force and effect.
- 10. REPRESENTATIONS.** The undersigned acknowledges that, in executing these terms and conditions, he/she has not relied on any inducements, promises or representations other than as set forth herein.

MEMBERSHIP POLICY AGREEMENT

The mission of the Boys & Girls Club of Pasadena is to enable all young people, especially those who need us most, to reach their full potential as productive, caring, healthy, and responsible citizens. Before becoming a member of the Boys & Girls Club of Pasadena, all children and enrolling families must agree to observe the following behavioral standards while participating in Club programs:

1. MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

- All members must have a current application and a signed "Membership & Policy Agreement" on file at the membership office of the Boys & Girls Club branch they attend.
- Check-in at the membership office is required of all members and non-members.
- Membership is for youth ages 6-18 only.
- If youth is 18-years old at time of enrollment, Club Member must be enrolled in high school.

2. MEMBERSHIP FEES

- All memberships expire May 31, 2019.
- The current enrollment fee is \$100.00. Additional fees may be charged for summer program, summer camp, swimming lessons, music lessons, etc.
- Transportation service during the **PUSD school year** is \$50.00 per month per Club Member. Transportation is not available for summer school. Transportation is offered according to the PUSD school schedule.
- **Late Fees of \$1.00 per minute will be applied when Club Member(s) are not picked up on time.**

3. BEHAVIOR

- All members, families, and any individual assigned and approved to pick-up or drop-off members must show respect for staff and other members at all times while at the Club. Inappropriate behavior of others may impact the membership of a child.
- All members are expected to select a weekly schedule of activities and are encouraged to participate in selected activities as scheduled.
- The use of foul language is not permitted at the Club.
- Verbal abuse is not allowed at the Club. (This includes the use of racial slurs, and negative descriptive terms.)

4. ATTIRE

- All members must wear shirts and closed toe shoes while at the Boys & Girls Club of Pasadena.
- No sagging pants or bare mid-drifts are allowed while inside the Club.
- No wet clothes are allowed other than in the swimming area.
- Any member dressed inappropriately will be asked to leave. A Member's Parent/Guardian will be asked to pick up children if dressed inappropriately.

5. HEALTH & SAFETY

- The Boys & Girls Club of Pasadena has an open door policy for children ages 13 and up, however no members are allowed to leave Club(s) premises without a signed "**Authorized to Release Form.**"
- For safety reasons, use of bicycles, roller blades, and skateboards are not permitted on the premises.
- No running is allowed other than in the Gymnasium.
- No loitering or playing in the parking area, or non-supervised areas.
- The Boys & Girls Club of Pasadena reserves the right to ask any Club member to leave the property in the event he/she is sick or has visible signs of pink eye, lice, or ringworm.
- Only soap and water and basic first aid will be used when assisting members with injuries.

6. FOOD

- Gum chewing is not allowed at the Boys & Girls Club of Pasadena.
- All food and drink must be consumed in the designated eating areas.
- All members **must use waste containers for trash.**
- No soda, hot and spicy snacks (eg. Hot Cheetos), or dried ramen (eg. Cup 'O Noodles).
- No seeds allowed at the Boys & Girls Club of Pasadena. This includes, but is not limited to, sunflower seeds, pumpkin seeds, etc.

7. PERSONAL BELONGINGS

- The Boys & Girls Club of Pasadena **is not responsible for lost or stolen items.**
- All members should keep the number of personal items they bring to the Club at a minimum

- All members should store book bags, swimsuits, towels, musical instruments, etc. in designated areas for safekeeping.
- Cash should be kept on your person at all times.
- No using personal devices (I.E. tablets, cellphones, etc) to access inappropriate sites or to take pictures or videos of other members, including "selfies" or self-portraits. Personal electronic devices should NOT be used during Power Hour, Programs, or when instructed by staff and volunteers. **Accessing social media within the Club is always prohibited.**

8. EARLY ARRIVALS AND LATE PICK-UPS

- No early drop-offs. Children should not be left unsupervised before the Club opens. The Boys & Girls Club of Pasadena assumes no responsibility until the Club's scheduled opening time.
- All late pick-ups will be charged \$1.00 per minute.
- Your child may not return to the Club until all fees are paid.
- If you are late, you should notify the Club immediately. **If an employee or your child cannot reach you by phone** and you have not picked up your child after 30 minutes, the Pasadena Police Department may be notified and custody of the member will be transferred to the police.
- Parents are responsible for knowing the Club's hours of operation.

9. MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

- The Boys & Girls Club of Pasadena reserves the right to revoke membership privileges of any member, related person, or otherwise connect individual who does not keep in compliance with the Membership Policy Agreement.

10. PHOTO RELEASE

11. SWIM LESSONS & MUSIC PROGRAM PAYMENT POLICY

To reserve your lesson time payment must be made upon reservation, but we are willing to work out a payment schedule with our families, as long as it is communicated by the family to the staff. If payment arrangements are not made by the second week, the student may lose his or her reserved lesson. **Should the instructor need to cancel, a make-up lesson will be offered to the student.**

- Vandalism, disruption of services, attempting to circumvent security measures, spreading computer viruses or worms, viewing/transmitting pornography, promoting hate sites and installing software is prohibited.
- You are personally liable for any copyright violations or unauthorized bills incurred.
- You are responsible for any damages incurred by inappropriate use of computers and equipment.

Parent Initials my child will follow all of the rules and expectations set by the Boys & Girls Club of Pasadena.

PLEASE NOTE: If thunder or lightning occurs 30 minutes before any aquatic activity, it is the policy of the Boys & Girls Club of Pasadena to cancel those activities for the safety of our members. This policy is recommended by the National Lightening Safety Institute. Because swimming pools are connected to a much larger surface area via underground water pipes, gas lines, electric and telephone wiring, etc., lightning strikes to the ground anywhere on this metallic network may induce shocks elsewhere.

All patrons will be required to complete a swim assessment prior to entering the pool.

Pool Rules:

- No swimming when pool is closed.
- No swimming when lifeguard is not on duty.
- No running on deck.
- No dunking, splashing, or horseplay inside the pool.
- No diving or jumping in any depth under 5 ½ feet.
- No toys, floating devices, snorkels or masks allowed in the pool—unless part of an authorized class.
- No gum, chewing, spitting, spouting, nose blowing or urinating in the pool.
- No consumption of food or glass containers allowed in the pool area.
- Socializing with or distracting the lifeguard on duty is prohibited.
- Only appropriate swim wear is allowed in the pool.
- All swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
- All patrons must abide by lifeguard's rules and regulations.
